These are the ideal conditions, but in case of difficulty, please contact us.

Stage area – set-up:

- 9 metre diameter circle, including the spectator area + an entrance 2 metres wide and 3 metres long
- Required available height: 4 metres.
- Smooth level flat surface, in wood, concrete, lawn, etc...
- Calm and quiet situation: courtyard, garden, clearing, little place with not much going past...
- The scenery is a circular self-supported counter (6.20 metres diameter) around which the public are seated, as well as a public access archway.
- The company provides all the equipment for the setup of the public space (chairs / stools etc)
- Nearby drinking water point required (see Water and Waste).
- Contact us for inside dates.

Stage visits

- Other propositions are possible up to the beginning of the afternoon (contact us for details).

Various:

- Public capacity: 45 people
- Length of show: 66 minutes / Entrance and public access 10 minutes before the start of the show.
- Allow for access for a pickup trailer and a van up close to the stage, as well as parking during the entire time the company is present on site.
- Size of vehicle: height = 3m / length = 5.9m / width = 1.9m
Maximum size of trailer: height = 2.45m / length = 4.1m / width = 2.25m
- Provide access to a washing machine and tumble dryer. If this is not possible, please let us know.
- If possible nearby: allow access to a communal dishwasher and kitchen sink.

Water and waste:

- Allow access to a nearby drinking water point and waste water point less than 20 metres from the site. (breakfast preparation: kitchen for preparation of tea, coffee and washing up).
- This water point must be accessible for percolators 40 cm high.
- If this is not possible, please let us know and provide 60 litres of drinking water.
- Allow access to nearby recycling containers for rubbish.

Sound:

- The company provides all sound equipment.

Light:

- If necessary please contact us about the fire security plan.

Electricity:

- Supply two separate 16 amp electric supplies (see plan for location) protected with a 30 amp fuse. The company

provides two 25 metre extension leads for supply on stage. One lead supplies 2 percolators (2 x 1.6kw) and the second is for the sound equipment.

Safety and security:

- Use of a tripod gas burner, on stage, during the show.
- Provide a water + additive fire extinguisher and a CO2 extinguisher next to the stage.

Weather conditions:

- In case of rain forecast, *alternative arrangements* (see below) might be envisaged on arrival of the team.
- The outside show cannot be held during rain.
- The show cannot be held with temperature conditions less than 12°:

The contortionists' backs are severely affected by the cold.

Alternative arrangements:

- Stage area: a square measuring 11.5 m x 11.5 m, public space included.
- Height required: 4 m.
- Flat smooth wooden or concrete floor (no sloping areas)
- The decision for this alternative solution is taken at least one hour before the original planned stage assembly preparation time.
- The company can provide their own light stands, in which case please provide 7 weights of a minimum 10kg.

Plan for support crew required: if possible the same team throughout all performances

- Two days prior to show:
 - Company arrival
- The day before the show:
 - Company arrival on site, briefing time 30 min
 - Unloading and setup of scenery, electricity, stage and kitchen area, time 4 hours
personnel required: 2 people
 - Training, rehearsal time 1 hour
personnel required: 0
- Day of show :
 - Company arrival on site 3 hours prior to start of show. (allow access to rest area and toilets from this point)
 - Preparation and warm up etc.../ Time 3 hours
personnel required: 0
 - Show duration 1 hour 10 minutes
personnel required: 1 person to receive the public 30 minutes before the start of the show.
 - Public exit and comedians rest / Time 30 minutes
personnel required: 0
 - If a show the following day: washing up, tidying, laundry and stage preparation / Time 2 hours
personnel required: 2 people
 - If last show: washing up, tidying, laundry, dismantling and loading / Time 3 hours
personnel required: 3 people
- The day following the last show: company leave.

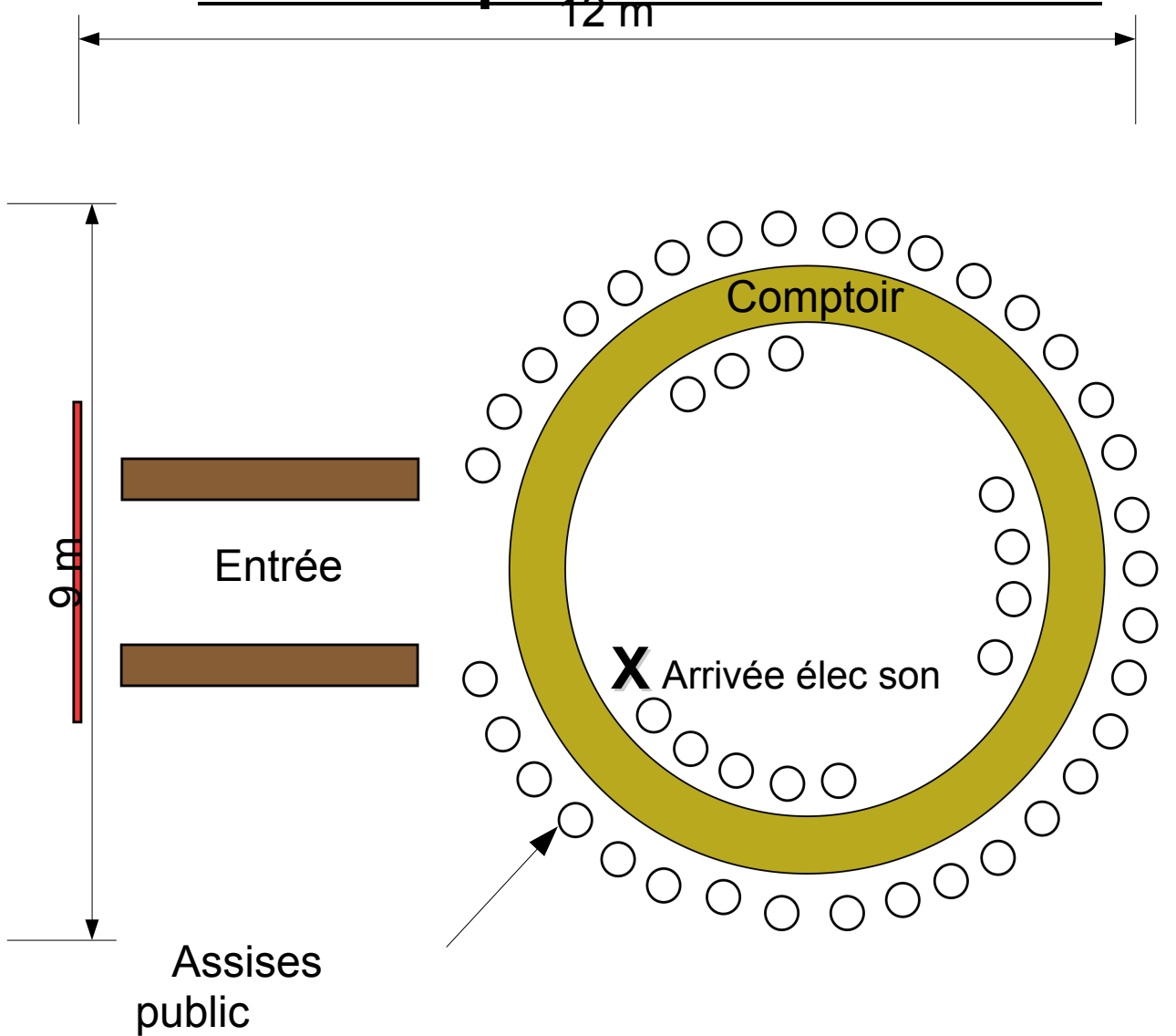
Company rest area:

- Provision required for heated restroom, available from the day before the first show until the company leave on the day following the last show, for three people, near the show location, with washing and toilet facilities, mirrors, chairs, hooks, and with provision of sweet and savoury snacks and bottles of water etc

Accommodation / catering:

- 3 or 4 adults and a baby (3 comedians, 1 production manager)
- Accommodation near the show venue (less than 15 minutes by car)
1 double room + baby and 1 or 2 single rooms
- Holiday cottage accommodation preferred, or happy to accept B & B
- Meals to be paid for by the organiser from the beginning to the end of the stay.
- Specific dietary requirements: one person allergic to peppers
- Team leave on the morning of the day following the last show.
